Cash Count

The auditor conducted a surprise cash count at the Bacliff office on August 1, 2018 and at the Texas City office on August 6, 2018. All collections were accounted for at the time of the surprise cash counts. Controls are in place to ensure the staff uses a lockable safe to secure collections until ready to be deposited. The safe remains locked when not in use.
