when the following proceedings, among others, were had, to-wit

**An Order Designating the County Commissioners' Courtroom Located on the First Floor of the Galveston County Courthouse, 722 Moody, Galveston, Texas as the Location for Conducting Sheriff Sales and the First Floor Lobby of the Galveston County Courthouse as the Location for Conducting Non-Judicial Foreclosures Commencing May, 2011.**

**Be it Ordered as Follows:**

That inasmuch as the Commissioners' Court of Galveston County is currently holding its weekly meetings and workshops at 1 00 p m on each Tuesday of the month and inasmuch as conducting Sheriff's Sales and Non-Judicial Foreclosures in the same location at the same time could prove to be problematic, and inasmuch as a solution, the Galveston County Sheriff has committed himself to conduct future monthly sheriff sales at 10 00 a m , pursuant to Texas Property Code §51 002 and Texas Tax Code §34 01 (r) the Commissioners' Court designates the following location, to-wit

Galveston County Commissioners' Courtroom  
Galveston County Courthouse, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor  
722 Moody (21<sup>st</sup> Street)  
Galveston, Texas 77550

as the location for the conduction of sheriff sales and the following location, to-wit

Lobby  
Galveston County Courthouse, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor  
722 Moody (21<sup>st</sup> Street)  
Galveston, Texas 77550

as the location for the conduction of non-judicial real property foreclosures such as powers of sale conferred by a deed of trust or other contract lien

The above locations shall be used beginning with sales being conducted in May of 2011

**Be it Further Ordered** that the posting of the notices required under Texas Tax Code §34 01 (h) and the posting of the notice required under Texas Property Code §51 002 (b) (1) be conducted at the following location

Display Case adjacent to the Courthouse Door (South Entrance)  
County Courthouse  
722 Moody (21<sup>st</sup> Street)  
Galveston, Texas 77550

**Be it Further Ordered** that a copy of this Order be placed in the real property records of the Office of the County Clerk, that a second copy of this Order be furnished to the Sheriff, that a third copy of this Order be prominently displayed where foreclosures and tax sales were previously conducted at the Commissioners' Court Courtroom, a fourth copy of this Order be posted on the County Clerk's website and that a fifth copy be distributed to members of the Galveston County Bar Association

**Be if Further Ordered** that the Order heretofore passed by this Court at its meeting held on March 8, 2011 be rescinded by this Order once the May sales have been conducted

**Be it Further Ordered** that this Order shall become effective immediately upon its passage subject to the exceptions set forth in the immediately preceding paragraph

**Upon Motion Duly Made and Seconded, the Above Order** was unanimously passed on this the 15<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2011
