


NO!


What should you do if a stranger

3. Tell a grown up.


Stranger Danger!

4. help find a lost pet ...



Ride single file.



Do not give a friend a ride on your bike. Riding double is dangerous

If the traffic is heavy at a crosswalk, walk your bike.


Wear elbow pads.

Use your hand signals for every turn.






Obey Traffic Laws When You Are Riding A Bike.




Always Stop At Stop Signs.

Know Street Signs.




What does each one mean?
