_____ Experts for Petitioner shall be designated by this date. An expert not designated by this date shall not be permitted to testify absent a showing of good cause.

_____ Experts for all other parties must be designated by this date. An expert not designated by this date shall not be permitted to testify absent a showing of good cause.

_____ Inventories and Appraisements shall be filed by this date.

_____ Discovery shall be completed by this date. Counsel may, by agreement, continue discovery beyond this deadline. However, such continued discovery will not delay the trial date. *See* LOCAL RULE 4.14B.

_____ Amendments to pleadings, Request for Relief, Proposed Property Division and any other documents required by the Local Rules shall be filed by this date.

_____ Pre-Trial Conference will be held at 9:00 a.m. Failure to attend pre-trial conference shall result in the Court either dismissing the case for want of prosecution or entering a default judgment.

_____ Bench Trial / One week docket. If the case is not reached for trial, the Court will reset the trial date.

_____ Jury Trial / Two week Docket. If the case is not reached for trial, the Court will reset the trial date.
