1. \_\_\_\_\_ **Deadline for completing “For Kids Sake.”** The parties shall attend and certify the same to the Court that no less than four (4) hours of an approved parenting class, i.e., “For Kids Sake,” has been completed. “For Kids Sake” enrollment forms may be obtained from the Galveston County Law Library.
2. \_\_\_\_\_ **Deadline for designation of experts by party seeking affirmative relief.** Deadline for designation of experts by party responding to affirmative relief shall be thirty (30) days hereafter. No additional experts will be permitted to testify, except for good cause shown. Failure to timely respond will be governed by Rule 193.6.
3. \_\_\_\_\_ **Deadline for amending pleadings.**
4. \_\_\_\_\_ **Deadline for filing Sworn Inventories and Appraisements.**
5. \_\_\_\_\_ **Deadline for completing Alternative Dispute Resolution.**
6. \_\_\_\_\_ **Deadline for completing all discovery.**
7. \_\_\_\_\_ **Deadline for filing all motions.**
8. \_\_\_\_\_ **Pre-Trial Conference** will be held at 1:30 P.M. All counsels are ordered to attend and must be prepared to discuss all aspects of the suit and trial. Failure to appear will be grounds for dismissal for want of prosecution. Seven (7) days prior to, all counsels shall exchange proposed requests for relief, property division, witness lists, updated financial information statements with supporting documentation, exhibit lists and exhibits, and jury questions, definitions and instructions, if applicable. The parties shall also file a completed “Pretrial Conference Checklist,” copy of which may be found on the Court’s website at <http://www.co.galveston.tx.us/Countycourt3/Courtforms.htm>.
9. \_\_\_\_\_ **Bench / Jury Trial** will be held at \_\_\_\_\_ A.M./P.M. Any Court Ordered continuance of this trial setting will not alter any other deadlines established within this Order.
