**JURY FINDS MAN GUILTY OF POSSESSION OF COCAINE WITH INTENT TO DELIVER  
AND TAMPERING WITH EVIDENCE**

January 28, 2015

GALVESTON – Today a jury convicted Anthony Deon Bradford of the felony offenses of Possession of a Controlled Substance with Intent to Deliver (4-200 grams) and Tampering with Evidence.

Members of the Crime Suppression Unit at the Texas City Police Department stated in an affidavit requesting a search warrant that a confidential source informed them that a man named “Baytown” was selling drugs out of a residential address in Texas City. Officer’s stated they conducted surveillance of the home and noticed behavior consistent with the sale of narcotics. Officer’s also had the confidential informant go into the home and purchase cocaine to verify that drugs were being sold. Based off of this information the police were able to obtain a search warrant. Officer’s testified that when they first entered the residence they heard the toilet flush and saw off-white colored rocks in the bowl. More of the same substance was found in the bathroom closet and the room that belonged to the defendant. A digital scale was also found in the room. The substances all tested positive for cocaine at the lab.

Bradford was prosecuted by Assistant District Attorneys Rebecca Russell and Andrea Kelley in the 122<sup>nd</sup> District Court, with Judge John Ellisor presiding, and Jim Bennett representing the defendant. The defendant elected to have his punishment assessed by the Judge at a later date. There are two felony enhancements in the indictment so the range of punishment the defendant faces is 25 years to life in prison.
