Except by agreement, on or before this date, Plaintiffs must file and serve a comprehensive written report for each testifying expert regarding Plaintiffs’ injuries (physical, mental, vocational, and economic) and causation thereof. The report shall include all of the expert’s opinions, as well as the information in Texas Rule of Civil Procedure 194.2. All materials required to be disclosed by Rule 194.2 (I)(4)(a) shall be served at this time of designation, except that materials such as depositions or documents that are of records shall be identified in a list that is served at this time of designation.</p>
<p>June 15, 2007</p>	<p>PLAINTIFF SPECIFIC DAMAGES – DEFENDANTS EXPERT DESIGNATION. Except by agreement, on or before this date, Defendants must file and serve a comprehensive written report for each testifying expert expected to testify regarding Plaintiffs’ injuries (physical, mental, vocational, and economic) and causation thereof. The report shall include all of the expert’s opinions, as well as the information in Texas Rule of Civil Procedure 194.2 All materials required to be disclosed by Rule 194.2 (I)(4)(a) shall be served at this time of designation, except that materials such as depositions or documents that are of records shall be identified in a list that is served at this time of designation.</p>
<p>July 25, 2007</p>	<p>PLAINTIFFS AMENDMENTS TO PLEADINGS. On or before this date, Plaintiffs shall file and serve all amendments to pleadings.</p>
<p>July 25, 2007</p>	<p>PLAINTIFFS’ EXHIBIT AND WITNESS LIST. On or before this date, Plaintiffs’ shall file a list of trial witnesses (distinguishing between those who are going to testify live versus by deposition). The Exhibit List shall include all exhibits the party will offer into evidence, and no party SHALL BE ALLOWED TO OFFER ANY Exhibit not so listed. The Witness List shall include the information required under Rule 194.2, T.R.C.P.</p>

On or before this date, Plaintiffs shall file and serve page/line designations for any deposition testimony that they intend to offer at trial. 	received after this date), must be designated in good faith and within a reasonable period of time such that all parties will have a reasonable opportunity to lodge objections to the proposed testimony.
July 25, 2007	DISCOVERY DEADLINE FOR PLAINTIFF-SPECIFIC DAMAGES. Unless otherwise agreed by the parties, all plaintiff-specific written discovery shall be served at such a time that no responses are due after this date. All depositions of fact witnesses regarding plaintiff specific matters shall be complete by this date.
Aug 1, 2007	DEPOSITION DEADLINE FOR EXPERTS REGARDING PLAINTIFF – SPECIFIC DAMAGES. Unless otherwise agreed by the Parties, on or before this date the parties shall have completed all depositions of experts regarding Plaintiff-specific damages.
Aug 6, 2007	DEFENDANTS’ AMENDMENTS TO PLEADINGS. On or before this date, Defendants shall file and serve all amendments to pleadings.
Aug 6, 2007	DISPOSITIVE MOTIONS AND CHALLENGES TO EXPERT TESTIMONY. On or before this date, all dispositive motions and all challenges to expert testimony must be filed and served.
Aug 6, 2007	DEFENDANTS’ EXHIBIT AND WITNESS LISTS. On or before this date, Defendant shall file a list of trial witnesses (distinguishing between those who are going to testify live versus by deposition), and their marked and numbered exhibit list. The Exhibit List shall include all exhibits the party will offer into evidence, and no party SHALL BE ALLOWED TO OFFER ANY Exhibit not so listed. The Witness List shall include the information required under Rule 194.2, T.R.C.P.
Aug 6, 2007	DEFENDANTS’ DEPOSITION TESTIMONY DESIGNATIONS. On or before this date, Defendants shall file and serve page/line designations for any deposition testimony that they intend to offer at trial related to Issues 1 and 2 and only for such fact witnesses related to Issues 1 and 2. Any additional deposition testimony intended to be used at trial, but not originally designated in accordance with this paragraph (i.e., for transcripts received after this date), must be designated in good faith and within a reasonable period of time such that all parties will have a reasonable opportunity to lodge objections to the proposed testimony.
Aug 13, 2007	OBJECTIONS TO DEPOSITION DESIGNATIONS, AND OBJECTIONS TO EXHIBITS. On or before this date, the parties shall file and serve objections to deposition designations, and objections to exhibits.
Aug 20, 2007	JURY QUESTIONNAIRE HANDED OUT/EVALUATED.
Aug 22, 2007	PRE-TRIAL HEARING TO DISCUSS ALL OUTSTANDING MOTIONS AND ITEMS FOR TRIAL. PRE-TRIAL MATTERS – HEARING ON CHALLENGES TO EXPERT TESTIMONY; JURY QUESTIONNAIRE
Aug 23, 24, 2007	VOIR DIRE.

Aug 27, 2007 TRIAL – OPENING STATEMENTS. Each party shall present its opening statement on this date and be limited to no more than 2 hours each.


