ORDER ON BOND

The defendant in the above styled and numbered cause has been charged with the felony offense of Tampering with Physical Evidence. Bail is set at one billion dollars (\$1,000,000,000.00).

Further the Court orders that the Defendant appear weekly in person in the 212th District Court on Friday mornings at 9:00am. Every Friday Sec

The Court additionally orders that the Defendant submit to weekly alcohol and drug screening/testing at the Galveston County Community Correction Supervision or other location as approved by the Court. The Court will designate the time and date to submit to the testing at random.

The Defendant is further ordered to be under twenty-four (24) hour supervision by a licensed peace officer of the State of Texas. The Defendant is ordered to pay the costs of the supervision as instructed by the Court.

The Defendant is not to leave Galveston/Harris counties without prior written approval of the Court.


The Defendant is ordered to surrender his passport and not obtain any other United States passports.

Called for

Additionally the Defendant shall:

1. Commit no offense against the laws of the State of Texas or of any other State, the United States or any governmental entity;
2. Avoid persons or places of disreputable or harmful character; and specifically avoid association with any person previously convicted of a crime, or presence at any location where a criminal act is being committed;
3. Report within forty-eight (48) hours to the Court any change of address, employment, or marital status, and any arrests;
4. Abstain from the use or possession of any drugs, except those taken or possessed under doctors orders;
5. Never become intoxicated;
6. Abstain from the use of alcohol in any form at any time and do not enter any bar, tavern, lounge or other similar place;
7. Observe a curfew and be home each night before 7 p.m. unless a later time is approved in advance by the Court;
8. The Defendant is ordered not to directly communicate with **any jurors, witnesses, or potential witnesses** either in person, in writing, by phone or through third parties or go near a residence, school or other location, to-wit: **where they may be located;**
9. The Defendant is responsible for all costs incurred;
