

WHAT IS THIS 1095-C?

1. What is Form 1095-C?

1095-C is a new required tax form that is provided to you by Galveston County; which includes information about your healthcare insurance coverage. Almost all employees will receive form 1095-C. Form 1095-C serves as a “proof of health insurance” that reports to the IRS that you have been properly covered by Galveston County. This is an additional form used when filing taxes.



2. Why am I receiving a 1095-C form?

1095-C is a new required form due to [Affordable Care Act](#) healthcare law.



3. When will I be receiving my 1095-C?

The federal deadline for employers to submit form 1095-C to employees is March 31, 2016.



For current employees the 1095-C is attached to your EFT statement dated March 16, 2016.



All past employees will receive their 1095-C via postal mail.



4. What do I do with this form?

Form 1095-C contains healthcare information for tax filing purposes.



5. Why did I not receive a 1095-C?

If you were not a full-time employee during 2015, you should not receive a 1095-C.



6. What if I misplace my 1095-C?

You may contact the Treasurer’s Office-Payroll Division at (409)770-5395 to request a copy. Copies may be picked up in the Treasurer’s Office or can be mailed to your address on file. Please bring a valid form of I.D. if you elect to pick up a copy. (Sorry electronic copies at this time are not available).
